Martingales are not allowed in flat classes.  
Polo wraps are allowed in equitation and  
jumper classes only. Bell boots are allowed  
for jumpers only unless approved by  
management/ judge in case of inclement  
weather.  
**MEMBERSHIP:** For a \$20.00 fee (\$5.00 per horse) riders  
may become SJHSA members. Once  
membership is established, class pints will  
count toward year end awards. Farm horse  
membership fee is \$40.00  
--Whipple Tree Farm, Dianne Gallatin, and the SJHSA reserve  
the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard  
to, or arising from any incident during the show without  
claims or damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not  
covered in the rule regulations shall be decided by the show  
committee; their decision is final.  
--The horse show committee reserves the right to refuse,  
accept conditionally, or cancel any awards without claim for  
damages. It reserves the right change or substitute course to  
combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes.  
--CONDITION OF ENTRY: Every horse entered for competition  
will be in control of the show management, but the Farm,  
Dianne Gallatin, nor SHJSA in no case will be responsible for  
any loss or damage which occur to any negligence on behalf  
of the Farm or SJHSA.  
--Entries must be paid by open check prior to issuing  
numbers.

HOPEFUL JUMPER—Fences 2' – 2'3". No cross entry in ring 2 divisions or other jumper divisions

TRAINING JUMPER – Fences 2'3" – 2'6". No cross entries into other jumper divisions. During the year if horse/ rider combination move into another jumper division, they may not return to training.

SCHOOLING JUMPER—Fences 2'9" – 3'. Open to all. No cross entry into other jumper divisions.

OPEN JUMPER—Fences 3' – 3'6" to start.

BABY GREEN HUNTER—Fences 2'3" – 2'6". Open to horses and ponies for current year only. No cross entries over 2'6".

PONY HUNTER—Fences 2'3"- 2'6". No in and outs. Open to ponies 14.2 and under ridden by junior riders.

NOVICE EQUITATION—Fences 2'3". For riders who have not shown over 2'6". Top 4 year-end award winners must advance next year. Riders are eligible for entire show year.

SCHOOLING HUNTER—Fences 2'6". Open to all.

LIMIT HUNTER—Fences 2'6". For riders who have not shown over 2'9" at any show. Riders are eligible for entire current show year.

LIMIT EQUITATION—Same rules- 1 flat, 1 O/F

JUNIOR/ADULT HUNTER—Fences 2'6". Open to all junior and amateur adults.

JUNIOR/ADULT EQUITATION- Same rules 1 flat, 1 O/F.

WALK EQUITATION—No cross entries into any other division. Year-end achievement awards after 1 blue ribbon, year-end medal after 3 blue ribbons.

WALK/TROT EQUITATION-- No cross entries into any other division. Year-end achievement awards after 1 blue ribbon, year-end medal after 3 blue ribbons.

PRE-BEGINNER EQUITATION—18" crossrails to be performed at a trot OR canter. For riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons at any show over fences. Year-end achievement awards after 1 blue ribbon, year-end medal after 3 blue ribbons.

ADULT BEGINNER—18" vertical fences. Open to adult riders who have not shown over 18". Riders are eligible for the whole show year. No cross entries other than flat classes.

BEGINNER EQUITATION—2' fences with a course of twice around. Last course may have one diagonal line. No cross entries except pony division. For riders who have not shown over 2'. Grand and Reserve year end award winners must advance.

ADULT EQUITATION—Fences 2' – 2'3". Simple figure "8" course. No in and outs. Open to all amateur adults 25 & older.
